

EYES ON THE ATM

ATMs are easy targets. Our cameras and sensors are integrated into one control panel that determines what's happening before issues arise.

PROPPED DOORS

The control panel can be programmed to tell when the door has been open too long, like five minutes instead of one, and send alerts to appropriate staff.

OPEN CASH DRAWER

Through simple control panel programming, sensors can detect when the drawer has been open too long, leaving the cash drawer unsecured, creating a risk for theft.





SUSPICIOUS LOITERING

Our cameras can be programmed to detect if a suspicious person is loitering near an ATM or in an unauthorized area.

EMERGENCY LOCKDOWN

Panic buttons can be hardwired and placed in a fixed discrete location. They can signal a silent alarm, a call for help, and/or initiate a lockdown.
